Doctoral Dissertation Award Arts & Humanities 2020-2021

Each year the Northeastern Association of Graduate Schools recognizes an outstanding dissertation that has been produced by a doctoral candidate at one of its member institutions. Nominees must have received the doctoral degree within five years preceding the year of competition. Therefore, people who completed all requirements for the degree after January 1, 2016 are eligible.

The 2020-2021 award will recognize a dissertation in the field of Arts & Humanities. The \$1,000 award recipient will be announced at the annual meeting.

Every member institution is invited to submit a nomination. There can be only one nominee from each institution. Nomination materials, which should be transmitted by the Graduate Dean, include:

- The dissertation
- 300 word abstract in lay language
- 3 letters of evaluation each explaining the original contribution to the field made by the dissertation
- A copy of the nominee's resume or CV

Submit all **nomination materials in a single pdf file format to NAGS.Awards@gmail.com by January 15, 2021.** Receipt of nomination materials will be confirmed by the chair of the NAGS Doctoral Dissertation Award Committee.
