**Doctoral Dissertation Award
2022-2023**

Physical Sciences, Mathematics, & Engineering

Each year the Northeastern Association of Graduate Schools recognizes an outstanding dissertation that has been produced by a doctoral candidate at one of its member institutions. Nominees must have received the doctoral degree within five years preceding the year of competition. Therefore, people who completed all requirements for the degree after January 1, 2018 are eligible.

The 2022-2023 award will recognize a dissertation in **Physical Sciences, Mathematics, & Engineering**.

The \$1,000 award will be presented at the annual meeting's award luncheon on Friday, April 21, 2023 at the Sheraton Harborside in Portsmouth, NH. The recipient will be invited to attend the meeting as a guest of the Association and **must be present to receive the award**.

Every member institution is invited to submit a nomination. There can be only one nominee from each institution. Nomination materials, which should be transmitted by the Graduate Dean, include the dissertation, a 300 word abstract in lay language, three letters of evaluation each explaining the original contribution to the field made by the dissertation, and a copy of the nominee's resume or CV. **Nomination materials in Adobe pdf file format must be submitted by email to NAGS.Awards@gmail.com. The deadline is January 15, 2023.** Receipt of nomination materials will be confirmed by NAGS Secretary-Treasurer.
